Dear Property Owner:

An inspection by our Division has determined this property is in violation of Bay County Code Section 17-2 - Prohibitions in the form of junk, trash, appliances, furniture, household garbage, unscreened/unused personal property and derelict vehicles.

The following action must be taken to correct the above stated violation(s):

- 1. All junk, trash, appliances, furniture and household garbage must be removed from the property and disposed of lawfully.
2. All but one derelict vehicle must be stored in an enclosed structure, made operable with current registration, or removed from the property.
3. All unscreened, unused personal property must be screened, properly stored, or removed from the property.

This correspondence will serve as official notification that the above stated violation must be corrected before December 4, 2023.

This case is scheduled to be presented to a special magistrate at the hearing on December 7, 2023 at 9:00 a.m., at the Bay County Government Center located at 840 W. 11th St., Panama City, Florida. If found in violation, the magistrate may order that the violations be corrected. Fines, liens or special assessments may be placed on the property for non-compliance and/or the costs of abatement by the County.
